What you will need:

RED HEART® Precious: 1 (1, 2, 2) balls 00001 Pearl

Circular Knitting Needles: 2.25 mm [US 1], one 40 cm [16"] long and one 60 cm [24"] long 2.75 mm [US 2], one 40 cm [16"] long and one 60 cm [24"] long

Stitch markers, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 37 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 57 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Welting Pattern Flat, using smaller needle. 33 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 53 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Welting Pattern Flat, using larger needle. **CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the tension/gauge.

Knit Girl's Poncho

Knit a beautiful poncho to keep your little girl stylish and warm. The yarn is a mohair blend, so it is warm and lightweight.

Directions are for size 2; changes for sizes 4, 6, and 8 are in parentheses.

Finished Neck Measurement: 39.5 (42.5, 42.5, 45) cm [15½ (16¾, 16¾, 17¾)].

Finished Bottom Measurement: 88.5 (92, 100.5, 104) cm [34¾ (36¾, 39½, 41)].

Finished Length: 21 (23.5, 25.5, 28) cm [8¼ (9¼, 10, 11)].

NOTE

Poncho is worked in the round from the neck down.

Special Abbreviations

kfb (Knit into front and back) = knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle.

ssk = slip next two sts knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loops.

Pattern Stitches

Welting Pattern Flat (multiple of 11 sts)

Note: This st pattern is for swatching purposes only; it will not be used in the pattern.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Rows 2-5: Knit.

Rows 6, 8, and 10: *K2tog, k2, [kfb] twice, k3, ssk; rep from * to end.

Rows 7, 9, and 11: Purl.

Row 12: Repeat Row 6.

Repeat Rows 1-12 for Welting Pattern Flat.

Welting Pattern A in the Round (multiple of 11 sts)

Rounds 1, 3, and 5: Purl.

Rounds 2 and 4: Knit.

Rounds 6, 8, and 10: *K2tog, k2, [kfb] twice, k3, ssk; rep from *.

Rounds 7, 9 and 11: Knit.

Round 12: Repeat Round 6.

Repeat Rounds 1-12 for Welting Pattern A in the Round.

Welting Increase Pattern (multiple of 11 sts doubles to 22 sts over 12 rounds)

Round 1: Purl.

Round 2: K5, yo, k6—12 sts.

Rounds 3 and 5: Purl, purling into back of yos to close holes.

Round 4: K5, yo, k1, yo, k6—14 sts.

Round 6: K2tog, k2, [kfb] twice, k1, [kfb] twice, k3, ssk—16 sts.

Rounds 7, 9, 11: Knit, knitting into back of yos to close holes.

Round 8: K2tog, k2, [kfb] twice, k3, [kfb] twice, k3, ssk—18 sts.

Round 10: K2tog, k2, [kfb] twice, yo, k1, ssk, k2tog, yo, [kfb] twice, k3, ssk—20 sts.

Round 12: K2tog, k2, [kfb] twice, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k1, yo, [kfb] twice, k3, ssk—22 sts.

Welting Pattern B in the Round (multiple of 13 sts)

Rounds 1, 3 and 5: Purl.

Rounds 2 and 4: Knit.

Rounds 6, 8, and 10: *K2tog, k3, [kfb] twice, k4, ssk; rep from *.

Rounds 7, 9, and 11: Knit.

Round 12: Repeat Round 6.

Repeat Rounds 1-12 for Welting Pattern B in the Round.

Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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PONCHO

With smaller 40 cm [16 inch] circular needle, cast on 143 (154, 154, 165) sts. Place marker for beginning of round. Join to work in round, being careful not to twist the sts. Work Rounds 1-12 of Welting Pattern A once.

Shape Poncho

Note: Change to smaller 60 cm [24"] circular needle when necessary for number of sts on needle.

Sizes 2 and 4 Only

Set-Up Round (Round 1 of pattern sts):

P33 (44, -, -), place marker, p33, place marker, p33 (44, -, -), place marker, p44 (33, -, -).

Sizes 6 and 8 Only

Set-Up Round (Round 1 of pattern sts):

[P33, place marker] 4 times, p- (-, 22, 33).

All Sizes

Next Round: [Work Round 2 of Welting Increase Pattern across 11 sts, work Round 2 of Welting Pattern A to marker, slip marker] 4 (4, 5, 5) times.

Continue in patterns as established through Round 12 of patterns, removing markers on last round—187 (198, 209, 220) sts.

Work 0 (0, 12, 12) rounds of Welting Pattern A.

Sizes 2 and 4 Only

Set-Up Round (Round 1 of pattern sts):

P33 (22, -, -), place marker, p77 (55, -, -), place marker, p66, place marker, p11 (55, -, -).

Sizes 6 and 8 Only

Set-Up Round (Round 1 of pattern sts):

P33, place marker, [p44, place marker] 3 times, p- (-, 44, 55).

All Sizes

Next Round: [Work Round 2 of Welting Pattern A to marker, slip marker, work Round 2 of Welting Increase Pattern across 11 sts] 3 (3, 4, 4) times, work Round 2 of Welting Pattern A to end.

Continue in patterns as established through Round 12 of patterns, removing markers on last round—220 (231, 253, 264) sts.

Work 12 rounds of Welting Pattern A.

Set-Up Round (Round 1 of pattern sts):

P88 (110, 77, 132), place marker, p99 (110, 110, 121), place marker, p33 (11, 66, 11).

Next Round: [Work Round 2 of Welting Pattern A to marker, slip marker, work Round 2 of Welting Increase Pattern across 11 sts] twice, work Round 2 of Welting Pattern A to end.

Continue in patterns as established through Round 12 of patterns, removing markers on last round—242 (253, 275, 286) sts.

Change to larger needle. Work Rounds 1-12 of Welting Pattern A.

Next Round: Purl.

Increase Round: *K5, yo, k1, yo, k5; repeat from * to end—286 (299, 325, 338) sts.

Work Rounds 3-12 of Welting Pattern B once, then Rounds 1-12 one (2, 2, 3) more time(s).

Next Round: Purl.

Next Round: *K2tog, k3, [kfb] twice, k4, ssk; repeat from * to end.

Repeat last 2 rounds 8 more times. Bind off all sts loosely purlwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

Abbreviations

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next two sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarnover; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
